Tuition

A deposit of \$200.00 must accompany this application.

Please note: No allowances will be made for late arrival or early departures. The Camp Health and Accident Group Insurance is included.

Laundry . . . (included in fee)

All clothing should be name taped for insurance against loss. Articles of clothing requiring special laundering or dry cleaning will be charged to the camper's account.

Camper's Personal Account

Your deposit of \$50.00 will be credited to your child's personal account in the camp bank. From this source he draws for the purchase of his personal necessities, stamps, stationery, toothpaste, films, etc. At the close of the season the balance will be refunded with a full statement on request. Golf green fees and some trips are charged to this account.

Transportation

Transportation charges will be billed on a round trip arrangement and are contingent upon point of origin. The Directors and an able staff supervise air and ground transportation from New York. A minimal charge will be made to cover in-transit food, taxes, taxis, bus, gratuities and chaperonage when required.

Tutoring

There is no formal tutorial program. Qualified staff members are assigned under the supervision of the Directors to conduct simple tutoring. The rate is two dollars per hour.

Visiting

In the best interests of campers and parents, *one* visiting day is set aside. It is usually the last Saturday of July. (An alternate day is offered and should *only* be considered in an *emergency* and with prior request.) A list of stopping places and instructions for travel will be mailed to you.

Health

The medical form must be completed by June 1st. The good health of the camp is maintained by our optimum attention to cleanliness, healthful practices, a resident nurse, and our visiting physician from a nearby community. Our infirmary is well-equipped, clean, and cheerful. Modern and highly efficient hospitalization is available a few short miles from camp.

Camp Outfit

All campers, including Senior House boys, are required to wear the prescribed uniforms and other articles of clothing as listed by the official camp outfitters, The Camp Shop, Fifth Avenue, New York City. In this way clothing is neat, easily laundered, and non-competitive. A complete list of items and sources of purchase will be mailed at a later date.
